Department of the Alforney General NOW, THEREFORE, I, LINDA LINGLE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Pupukea Beach Park, Governor's Executive Order 1760," situate at Pupukea, Koolauloa, Oahu, Hawaii, containing an area of 6.50 acres, more of less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 24,803 and dated April 14, 2009, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Executive Order No. 1760 dated October 8, 1956.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.


